

Free Web Site for your Quartet or Chorus???

Does your registered quartet (or chorus) have a its own web site? Well, if not, now it can. And it is *really* free! Seneca Land can offer you a one page website, set up on a sub domain of the district web site, at no charge. You provide the graphics and text that you want to use, and the District Webmaster will set up a one-page website for free.

The web address for your page, if your quartet's name were "XYZ Four", would be <http://xyzfour.senecaland.org> or something similar. Again, this would only be one page to give your group a web presence. If you want your own domain name such as www.xyzfour.org , you would have to purchase that separately and point it to the free page.

At this point, the only other conditions would be:

1. Your group must be registered with BHS.
2. Quartets, whose registration expires, will be removed within 30 days.
3. This is for groups currently without a web presence. If you have one, don't ask for another.
4. Most changes to the page would only be made annually, so don't put on information that you know will change. It is basically for contact information, short bio and a picture or two.
5. This is available on a first come, first served basis, based on available resources.
6. These terms and conditions are subject to change without notice.
